



**REBECCA STEWART (FOUNDER/PRESIDENT) BIOGRAPHY** // At a time when most elementary school students' primary priorities consisted of winning playground games, making successful school lunch trades and selecting the perfect Saturday morning cartoon to watch from a seemingly endless line-up, young Rebecca Stewart had her eyes set on a different goal altogether – owning and operating her very own business.

Stewart felt bitten by the business bug at a very early age. Originally, she dreamed of opening her very own smoothie shop in her hometown of San Luis Obispo, Calif., but fifteen years later, Stewart would parlay her drive for entrepreneurial success into establishing one of Southern California's premier household staffing companies for the region's busiest and most discerning clientele.

Always happy, smiling and joyful, Stewart grew up in a home that hinged upon the work of trustworthy, reliable household staff (Stewart's father is a quadriplegic, the result of an unfortunate mountain biking accident). Stewart combined her compassion for the human condition with her heart for service and enlisted in the Peace Corps, serving in Paraguay, South America for three months.

Upon returning to the United States, Stewart put her talents to good use and became a fulltime nanny for a high profile Hollywood family, a career she enjoyed for three years. While employed by the entertainment socialites, Stewart met a bevy of other nannies and future nannies who were searching for work. Before she knew it, Stewart's entrepreneurial spirit kicked into high gear and she began referring would-be caretakers to local families in need of household help. Armed with insatiable ambition and an "I could do that!" attitude, Stewart soon began researching, organizing and, then, established her own household staffing company.

Founded in August 2006, VIP Nannies Inc., Household Staffing (originally VIP Nanny Agency; the company became incorporated in 2010) aimed from day one to provide very important people with the very best nannies. Later that same year, VIP Nannies became a member of the International Nanny Association (INA) and, in 2009, a member of the Sherman Oaks Chamber of Commerce.

For Stewart, it's all about a client's happiness. She strives to remain in each and every one of her client's lives before, during and after the household staffing placement process. Known to many as the "Los Angeles Nanny Agent"; just as her A-list celebrity clients have agents who represent them, Stewart has a roster of nannies whom she represents. What separates Stewart's operation from other similar services can be summed up in two words: quality and speed. Every nanny that Stewart personally places with a family maintains a genuine passion for children – not to mention countless years of nanny experience, college degrees, preschool and elementary school teaching experience, are CPR certified and pass background checks with flying colors to start. Within 48 hours of fielding a request for a nanny, Stewart guarantees a minimum of three, quality candidates – near perfect matches – will be made available for interviews.

With her father as inspiration, Stewart strives to live each day to the fullest, believing that tomorrow is neither guaranteed nor promised. She works out at least three times a week (and participates in local 10K runs and walks with VIP Nannies staff) and thrives on her passion for meeting people and uncovering their life passions.
